



GUEST SERVICES GOLF CAR OPERATING GUIDE

(WARNING) FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS MAY RESULT IN SEVERE PERSONAL INJURY.

- Units may not operate in No Drive Zone areas during times they are in operation.
- Operate from the driver's side only. For non-highway use only and to be operated only by licensed drivers at least 18 years of age in designated areas.
- Golf carts must follow all normal traffic rules including stop signs and turn signals.
- Only two occupants per seat row. The number of passengers may not exceed the number listed on the unit's permit. Maximum payload is 800lbs.
- All occupants must be seated before moving direction selector to desired direction.
- Keep entire body inside vehicle and hold on when in motion.
- The use of powered carts on speedway property will be restricted to business use only.
- Alcoholic beverages are not permitted in any powered carts, except for closed containers for commercial delivery purposes. Guests bringing alcoholic beverages for personal use may only have alcoholic beverages in closed containers in their coolers.
- Golf carts will be driven in a safe, slow, and careful manner at all times while on speedway property. Drivers will yield to pedestrians. Anyone observed driving in a careless or unsafe manner would lose the privilege to drive a golf cart.
- Be sure occupants are seated, move direction selector to desired position, apply service brake, turn key "ON" and accelerate smoothly.
- To release parking (PARK) brake, depress service (lower) break pedal. To stop release accelerator pedal and apply service break.
- If the vehicle is fully loaded, it will take longer to stop than with no load.
- Before leaving vehicle, turn key "OFF" move the direction selector to 'forward' position and engage parking (PARK) brake.
- Remove key at all times when the driver is not seated in the driver's seat position.
- Drive slowly straight up and down slopes and in turns. Use extra care in reverse, in congested areas or on loose or grassy terrains.
- Reduce speed in wet areas.
- Apply service brake to control speed on steep grades.
- Never operate cart with direction selector in the neutral position.
- Vehicle must be serviced by qualified personnel only.
- Do not operate vehicle after daylight hours.
- ADA Golf Cart Drivers arriving to pick-up guests must:
 - Stop the cart, suppress the cart's brake into the locked position,
 - Remove the cart's key and exit the cart and stand beside it
 - Welcome and invite our guests to have an open seat,
 - Ensure that all passenger are properly seated,
 - Then be seated in the cart and check to be sure passengers are holding on before proceeding
