Arrival Guidelines



Arrival Policy

- Groups may begin to arrive as early as 6am on the morning of the first day of rental. Stage at Parking Lot 3; enter off of Bronson Hill Road.
- Participants can enter the track the evening before the first day of rental between 6pm and 9pm unless otherwise prohibited by contract. WGI personnel will notify the group when the track is clear for entry.
- Participants must leave by 9pm unless camping has been arranged for the group, through Luke Schock.

Drop Offs

- If just dropping off trailers in Lot 3, no insurance is needed for the day.

Set Up

- Participants can enter, unload, and set-up equipment only if the day is covered by an insurance certificate.

General Information

Ambulance Transports

- Our contract is with AMR Ambulance Service, who will transport patients to the appropriate facility per applicable off-line and/or on-line medical control.
- Any services performed by the ambulance crew while here at the facility are included in your rental payment to Track.
- If they do a transport, they will generate an invoice for the service via the patient's insurance company.
- They are required (per contract) to accept the fee that the patient's insurance company will pay for an ambulance transport, regardless of the amount.

Unmanned Aerial System (UAS) (Drones)

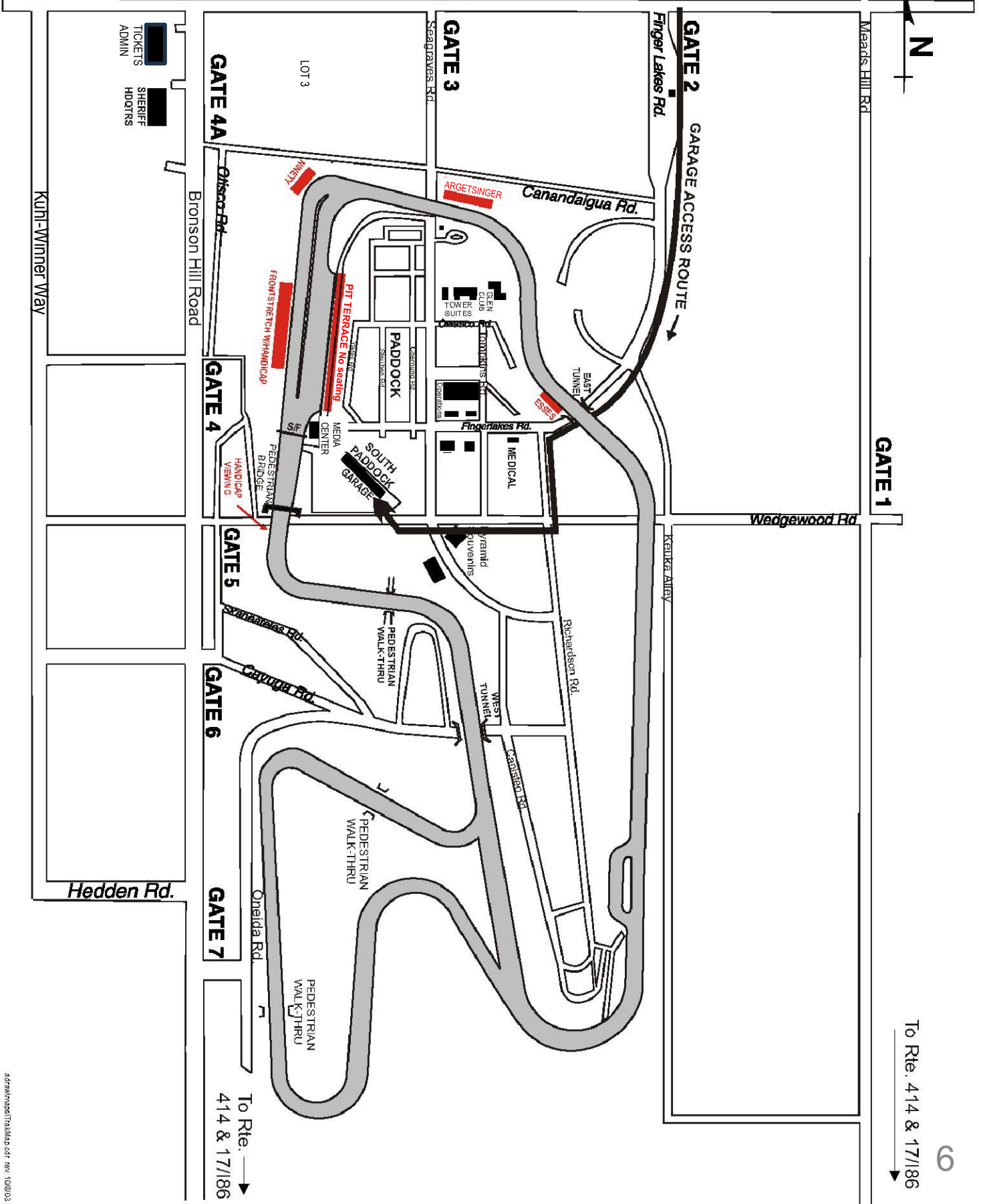
- Track strictly prohibits the use of unmanned aerial systems (“UAS”), also known as drones, for any purpose whatsoever on the premises, unless prior permission is granted prior to your track rental by Luke Schock.
- A UAS, for purposes of this agreement, is any aircraft or flying device without a human pilot aboard.
- Track personnel may remove anyone using a UAS on the premises and confiscate the UAS until the event is over if the rental group does not have prior permission.

County Rte. 16

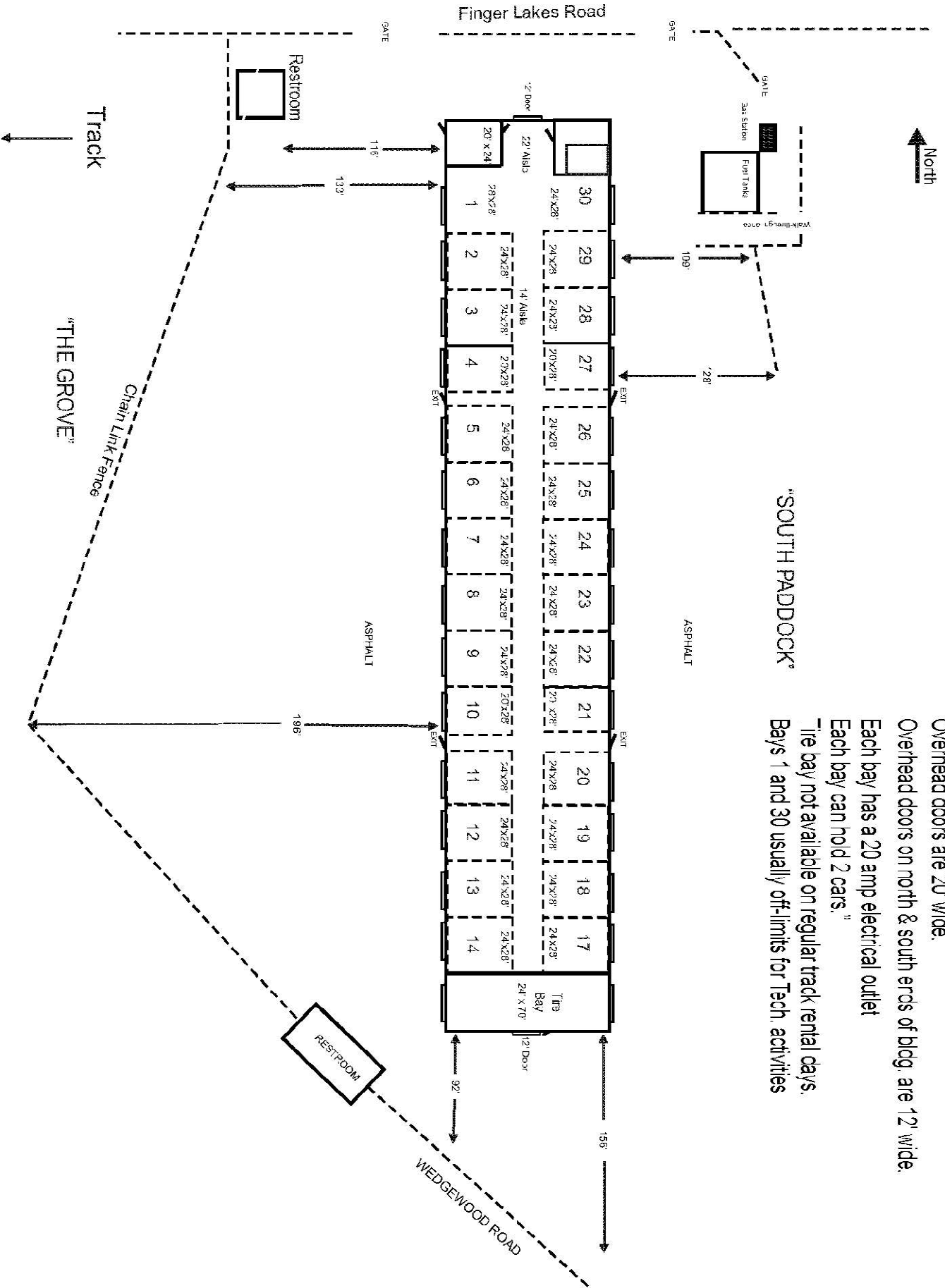
To Rte. 14, 414, 17, I-90 →

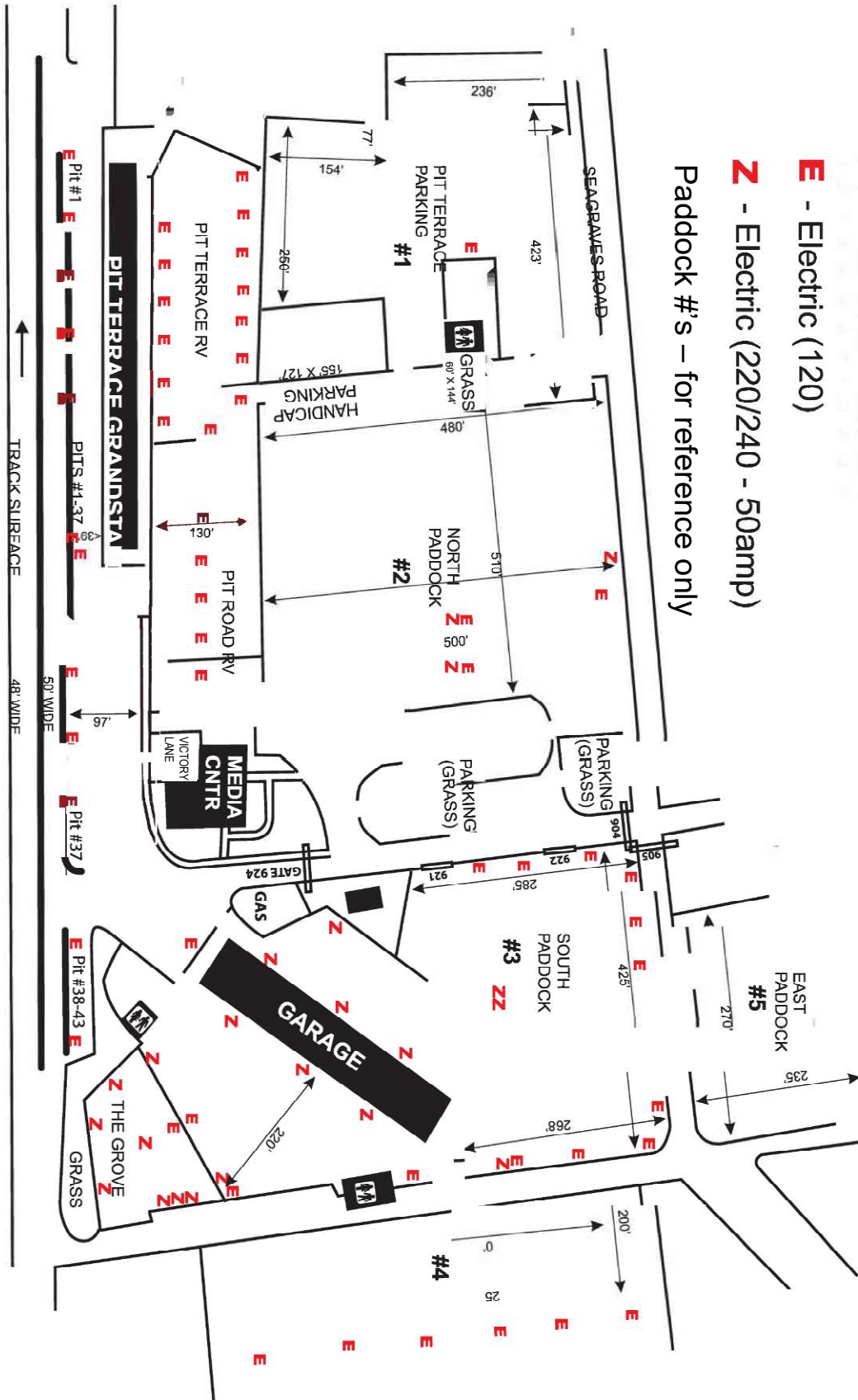

- NOTES:**
- Bldg. exterior measures approx. 70' x 400'.
 - Overhead doors are 20' wide.
 - Overhead doors on north & south ends of bldg. are 12' wide.
 - Each bay has a 20 amp electrical outlet
 - Each bay can hold 2 cars. "
 - Tire bay not available on regular track rental days.
 - Bays 1 and 30 usually off-limits for Tech activities

Paddock, Pits & Garage Area

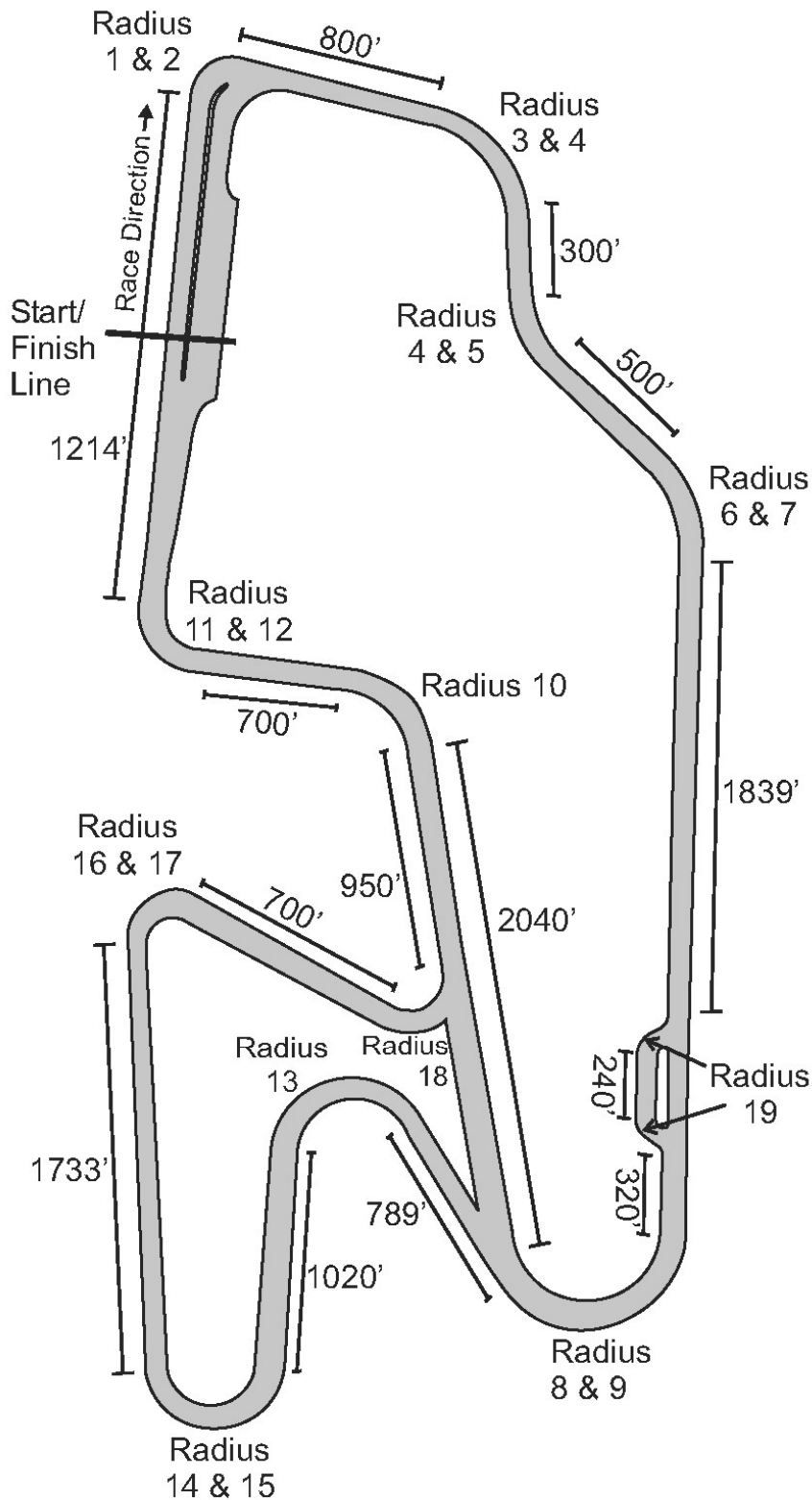


E - Electric (120)

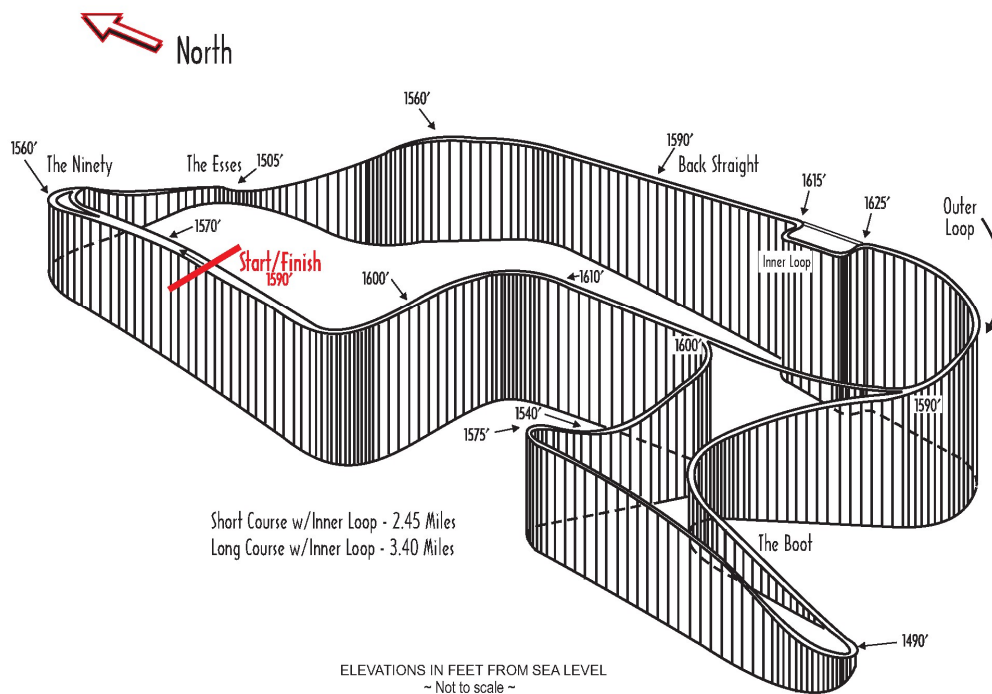

Track Walk



- A Track Walk is an opportunity for the group to walk the track and learn about the corners, apexes, etc.
- Track Walk generally starts at 5:30pm, following our 5pm “Drive The Glen” program for the public. Organizers, please request via Luke Schock at least 2 weeks prior to the track rental date.
- No bikes, golf carts, roller skates, etc. without prior permission from Luke Schock.
- Track personnel will conduct the walk. Car-pooling to get from one stop to the next is allowed, with WGI Security Staff accompanying the group.
- Please meet at the track entrance on the north end of the garage to depart. This experience should take approximately one hour.
